During the watercolor portion of class, we will explore the many options of waterColor, including using basic supplies that can be found in any home!



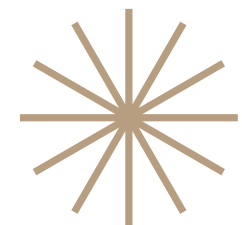
