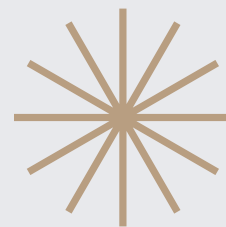

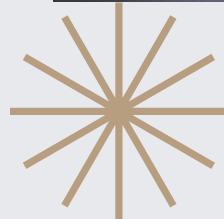

Yearbook

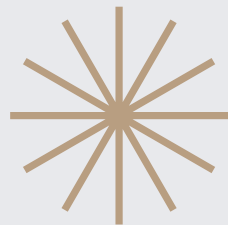
